

The Parish Council continues to express concern that the development of NW Preston is changing the rural character of the Parish and construction traffic and roadworks are having a major impact on the local roads. To help plan your journey, you can find details of all current and proposed road works on the LCC website http://mario.lancashire.gov.uk/roadworks/bulletin.aspx

Lancashire County Council has submitted plans to build the E-W link road and the Preston West Distributor (linking the M55 with the A583 at Lea.) It is hoped that these roads will be approved, built and completed on time - 2017 for the E-W link and 2019 for the PWDR. The application is due to go before LCC's committee in September.

Preston City Council has updated the Masterplan for NW Preston which includes 2 primary schools, a secondary school, health centre, leisure facility and 4 community centres. The Parish Council has replied by questioning the phasing for the proposed facilities as the plan does not include any details of when these will be provided.

The Masterplan includes details of 4 major new parks / open space. A **Western Park** off Sidgreaves Lane following the alignment of the overhead power lines, an **Eastern Park** abutting the M55, an **English Woodland Buffer** along the M55 and a **Green Corridor** along the E-W Link Road. **Land Trust** have been commissioned to look at how the parks and open space will be managed and maintained and the Parish Council is currently investigating how it can be involved in that process.

WOODPLUMPTON PARISH COUNCIL FINANCIAL REPORT FOR 1st APRIL 2015 TO 31st MARCH 2016

After the deduction of un-cleared cheques, the financial year began with a carried forward balance of £16,195.

The Council resolved to set the budget at £27,506, however the Parish Council is under increasing pressure to process queries and increase services due to cuts imposed by the principle authorities. In order to meet these costs without depleting reserves, the Council resolved to increase the precept from £18,375 to £26,375 the first increase since 2010.

During 2015/2016, the Council received a new payment called **Community Infrastructure Levy.** This income may only be used to improve and provide infrastructure to meet the demands of new development in the area. The payment has currently been invested in the Public Sector Deposit Fund until the infrastructure projects have been prioritised, agreed and authorised.

Itemised Income and Expenditure for the year is recorded below. The bank balance closed at £21,522 (after reconciliations for uncleared cheques) and £72,807 is invested in the Public Sector Deposit Fund.
