#### **UPDATE ON CIL ITEMS**

The Parish Council is pleased to announce that the refurbishment of **Woodplumpton War Memorial** is nearing completion.

New paving stones and stone pillars have been added and the work will be completed with black railings inset with red iron poppies.





A climbing frame and trampoline have also been installed at **Woodplumpton Play Area.**The Parish Council has funded the works with a £1,000 grant from TESCO Bags of Help.

Grass seed has been sown around the equipment and its growth will be closely monitored.

**Defibrillators** have been installed outside the Wheatsheaf Public House and Catforth Village Hall. NW Ambulance Service have offered to provide training sessions on the defibrillators.

The sessions will be a drop in event with no need to book.

# WOODPLUMPTON PARISH COUNCIL FINANCIAL REPORT FOR 1<sup>st</sup> APRIL 2016 TO 31<sup>st</sup> MARCH 2017

After the deduction of un-cleared cheques, the financial year began with a carried forward balance of £94,329.33 of which £21,522.37 remained in the bank account and £72,806.96. 2015/16 CIL monies were invested in the Public Sector Deposit Fund. CIL expenditure projects are included on a separate Business Plan.

Itemised Income and Expenditure for the year is recorded below.

After reconciliations for un-cleared cheques, the 2016/17 closing balance was £157,638.56 of which £72,806.96 CIL monies remain invested in the Public Sector Deposit Fund and £84,831.60 was carried forward in the bank account.

**Note** – Of the £84,831.60, **£59,640** relates to the CIL balance in the bank at the end of 2016/17. This amount will be spent on the refurbishment and installation of new equipment in Woodplumpton play area and new stone work around Woodplumpton war memorial – both of which started during this 2016/17 financial year.

#### 2017 / 2018

Under Minute 105 of the January 2017 meeting, Council resolved to set the budget at £26,460 and leave the precept at £26,375.
